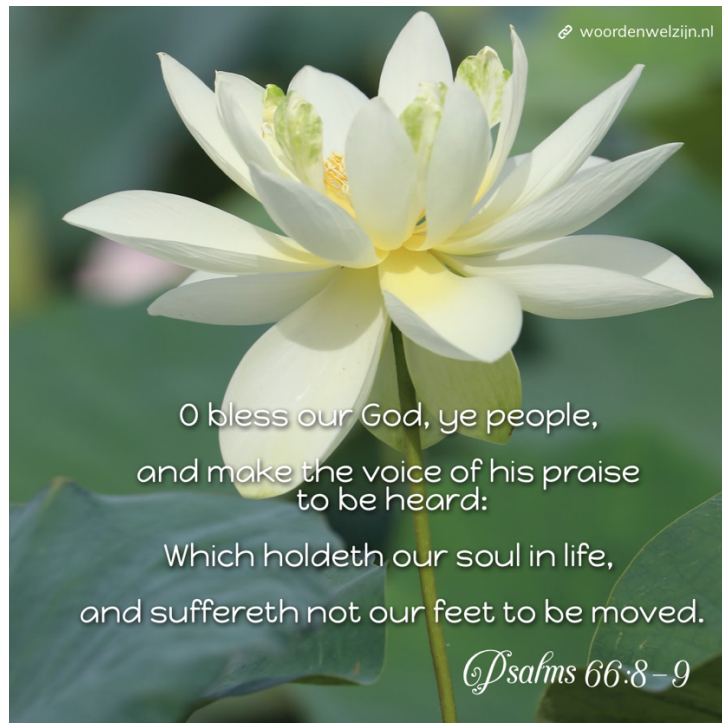

## Long life

### Deuteronomy 5:33

<sup>33</sup>Ye shall walk in all the ways which the LORD your God hath commanded you, that ye may live, and *that it may be well with you*, and *that ye may prolong your days* in the land which ye shall possess.

### Deuteronomy 6:1-2

<sup>1</sup>Now these *are* the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

<sup>2</sup>That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

### Job 5:26

<sup>26</sup>Thou shalt come to *thy* grave in a full age, like as a shock of corn cometh in in his season.

### Psalms 34:9-12

<sup>9</sup>O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for *there is* no want to them that fear him. <sup>10</sup>The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good *thing*. <sup>11</sup>Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD. <sup>12</sup><sup>s</sup>What man *is he that* desireth life, *and loveth many days*, that he may see good?

### Psalms 91:16

<sup>16</sup>With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

### Proverbs 3:1-2, 16

<sup>1</sup>My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments: <sup>2</sup>For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

<sup>16</sup>Length of days *is* in her right hand; *and* in her left hand riches and honour.

### Proverbs 9:11.

<sup>11</sup>For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.



## Health

3 John 1:2

<sup>2</sup>Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

Psalms 103:2-5

<sup>2</sup>Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: <sup>3</sup>Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; <sup>4</sup>Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; <sup>5</sup>Who satisfieth thy mouth with good *things*; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Proverbs 3:7-8

<sup>7</sup>Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. <sup>8</sup>It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

Proverbs 4:20, 22

<sup>20</sup>My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. <sup>22</sup>For they *are* life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

## High age

Psalms 71:9

<sup>9</sup>Cast me not off in the time of old age; forsake me not when my strength faileth.

Isaiah 46:4

<sup>4</sup>And *even* to *your* old age I *am* he; and *even* to hoar hairs will I carry *you*: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and will deliver *you*.

Proverbs 16:31

<sup>31</sup>The hoary head *is* a crown of glory, *if* it be found in the way of righteousness.



## Deliverance from sickness

Exodus 23:25

<sup>25</sup>And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.

Exodus 15:26

<sup>26</sup>And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

Job 33:24-26,28

<sup>24</sup>Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom. <sup>25</sup>His flesh shall be fresher than a child's: he shall return to the days of his youth: <sup>26</sup>He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness. <sup>28</sup>He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light.

Psalms 91:3, 5-6

<sup>3</sup>Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence.  
<sup>5</sup>Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the arrow *that* flieth by day;  
<sup>6</sup>*Nor* for the pestilence *that* walketh in darkness; *nor* for the destruction *that* wasteth at noonday.

Deuteronomy 7:15

<sup>15</sup>And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all *them* that hate thee.

Jeremiah 33:6

<sup>6</sup>Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth.



## Support in sickness

Psalms 41:2-3

<sup>2</sup>The LORD will preserve him, and keep him alive; *and* he shall be blessed upon the earth: and thou wilt not deliver him unto the will of his enemies. <sup>3</sup>The LORD will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: thou wilt make all his bed in his sickness.

Psalms 116:6-8

<sup>6</sup>The LORD preserveth the simple: I was brought low, and he helped me. <sup>7</sup>Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee. <sup>8</sup>For thou hast delivered my soul from death, mine eyes from tears, *and* my feet from falling.

Genesis 49:25

<sup>25</sup>*Even* by the God of thy father, who shall help thee; and by the Almighty, who shall bless thee with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the deep that lieth under, blessings of the breasts, and of the womb.

## Deliverance from death

Job 33:28

<sup>28</sup>He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light.

Psalms 68:19-20

<sup>19</sup>Blessed *be* the Lord, *who* daily loadeth us *with benefits*, *even* the God of our salvation. Selah. <sup>20</sup>*He that is* our God *is* the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord *belong* the issues from death.

Psalms 66:8-9

<sup>8</sup>O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of his praise to be heard: <sup>9</sup>Which holdeth our soul in life, and suffereth not our feet to be moved.



Psalms 102:19-20

<sup>19</sup>For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; <sup>20</sup>To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death.

Psalms 107:18-20

<sup>18</sup>Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death. <sup>19</sup>Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, *and* he saveth them out of their distresses. <sup>20</sup>He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered *them* from their destructions.

Psalms 116:3-4, 15-17

<sup>3</sup>The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow. <sup>4</sup>Then called I upon the name of the LORD; O LORD, I beseech thee, deliver my soul. <sup>15</sup>Precious in the sight of the LORD *is* the death of his saints. <sup>16</sup>O LORD, truly I *am* thy servant; I *am* thy servant, *and* the son of thine handmaid: thou hast loosed my bonds. <sup>17</sup>I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.

Psalms 91:7

<sup>7</sup>A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; *but* it shall not come nigh thee.

Psalms 9:12-13

<sup>12</sup>When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the humble. <sup>13</sup>Have mercy upon me, O LORD; consider my trouble *which I suffer* of them that hate me, thou that liftest me up from the gates of death.

1 Samuel 2:6

<sup>6</sup>The LORD killeth, and maketh alive: he bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up.

Deuteronomy 32:39

<sup>39</sup>See now that I, *even I, am* he, and *there is* no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither *is there any* that can deliver out of my hand.



## God listens to our prayers

Job 22:26-27

<sup>26</sup>For then shalt thou have thy delight in the Almighty, and shalt lift up thy face unto God. <sup>27</sup>Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows.

Psalms 4: 1, 3

<sup>1</sup>Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me *when I was* in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer. <sup>3</sup>But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the LORD will hear when I call unto him.

Psalms 34:4, 15

<sup>4</sup>I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. <sup>15</sup>The eyes of the LORD *are* upon the righteous, and his ears *are open* unto their cry.

Psalms 50:15

<sup>15</sup>And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me.

Psalms 65:1-2

<sup>1</sup>Praise waiteth for thee, O God, in Sion: and unto thee shall the vow be performed. <sup>2</sup>O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come.

Psalms 91:15

<sup>15</sup>He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

Psalms 145:19

<sup>19</sup>He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

Proverbs 15:29

<sup>29</sup>The LORD *is* far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous.





Isaiah 30:19

<sup>19</sup>For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: thou shalt weep no more: he will be very gracious unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee.

Isaiah 58:9

<sup>9</sup>Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I *am*.

Isaiah 65:24

<sup>24</sup>And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.

Jeremiah 29:12-14

<sup>12</sup>Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.

<sup>13</sup>And ye shall seek me, and find *me*, when ye shall search for me with all your heart. <sup>14</sup>And I will be found of you, saith the LORD: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith the LORD; and I will bring you again into the place whence I caused you to be carried away captive.

Zechariah 13:9

<sup>9</sup>And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, it *is* my people: and they shall say, The LORD *is* my God.

Matthew 7:7-8,11

<sup>7</sup>Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

<sup>8</sup>For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. <sup>11</sup>If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

Matthew 21:22

<sup>22</sup>And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

John 15:7

<sup>7</sup>If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.



John 16:23-24

<sup>23</sup>And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give *it* you. <sup>24</sup>Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

John 14:13-14

<sup>13</sup>And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. <sup>14</sup>If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do *it*.

James 5:15-16

<sup>15</sup>And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. <sup>16</sup>Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

1 John 3:22

<sup>22</sup>And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

1 John 5:14-15

<sup>14</sup>And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: <sup>15</sup>And if we know that he hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

## Divine guidance

Isaiah 30:21

<sup>21</sup>And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, this *is* the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

Psalms 73:23-24

<sup>23</sup>Nevertheless I *am* continually with thee: thou hast holden *me* by my right hand. <sup>24</sup>Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me *to* glory.



Psalms 23:2-3

<sup>2</sup>He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. <sup>3</sup>He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

John 14:13-14

<sup>13</sup>And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. <sup>14</sup>If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do *it*.

Isaiah 49:10

<sup>10</sup>They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them.

Deuteronomy 32:10 -12

<sup>10</sup>He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye. <sup>11</sup>As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings: <sup>12</sup>So the LORD alone did lead him, and *there was* no strange god with him.

## Grace and Mercy

Psalms 84:5

<sup>5</sup>Blessed *is* the man whose strength *is* in thee; in whose heart *are* the ways *of them*.

James 4:6

<sup>6</sup>But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

2 Thessalonians 3:3

<sup>3</sup>But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep *you* from evil.

2 Corinthians 1:20-21

<sup>20</sup>For all the promises of God in him *are* yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

<sup>21</sup>Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, *is* God;



1 Corinthians 1:8

<sup>8</sup>Who shall also confirm you unto the end, *that ye may be* blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 1:6

<sup>6</sup>Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform *it* until the day of Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

<sup>23</sup>And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>24</sup>Faithful *is* he that calleth you, who also will do *it*.

Romans 8:38-39

<sup>38</sup>For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, <sup>39</sup>Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Jude 1:24-25

<sup>24</sup>Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present *you* faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, <sup>25</sup>To the only wise God our Saviour, *be* glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

Deuteronomy 4:31

<sup>31</sup>(For the LORD thy God *is* a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

Romans 8:31

<sup>31</sup>What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us?

Hebrews 13:6

<sup>6</sup>So that we may boldly say, The Lord *is* my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

Isaiah 41:10, 13

<sup>10</sup>Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: be not dismayed; for I *am* thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. <sup>13</sup>For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.



John 1:16-17

<sup>16</sup>And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace. <sup>17</sup>For the law was given by Moses, *but* grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 1:22-23

<sup>22</sup>And hath put all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church, <sup>23</sup>Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

Isaiah 45:24-25

<sup>24</sup>Surely, shall *one* say, in the LORD have I righteousness and strength: *even* to him shall *men* come; and all that are incensed against him shall be ashamed. <sup>25</sup>In the LORD shall all the seed of Israel be justified, and shall glory.

God cares for us

1 Peter 5:7

<sup>7</sup>Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

Psalms 33:18

<sup>18</sup>Behold, the eye of the LORD *is* upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy.

Isaiah 46:3-4

<sup>3</sup>Hearken unto me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the house of Israel, which are borne *by me* from the belly, which are carried from the womb: <sup>4</sup>And *even* to *your* old age I *am* he; and *even* to hoar hairs will I carry *you*: I have made, and I will bear; *even* I will carry, and will deliver *you*.

Luke 21:18

<sup>18</sup>But there shall not an hair of your head perish.



Matthew 10:29-31

<sup>29</sup>Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father. <sup>30</sup>But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. <sup>31</sup>Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.

Isaiah 63:9

<sup>9</sup>In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old.

Deuteronomy 32:11-12

<sup>11</sup>As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings: <sup>12</sup>So the LORD alone did lead him, and *there was* no strange god with him.

Isaiah 44:21

<sup>21</sup>Remember these, O Jacob and Israel; for thou *art* my servant: I have formed thee; thou *art* my servant: O Israel, thou shalt not be forgotten of me.

Psalms 94:14

<sup>14</sup>For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance.

Isaiah 49:14-16

<sup>14</sup>But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me. <sup>15</sup>Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee. <sup>16</sup>Behold, I have graven thee upon the palms of *my* hands; thy walls *are* continually before me.

Isaiah 54:10

<sup>10</sup>For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the LORD that hath mercy on thee.

Hebrews 13:5

<sup>5</sup>*Let your conversation be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.



Psalms 9:9-10

<sup>9</sup>The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. <sup>10</sup>And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.

Isaiah 42:16

<sup>16</sup>And I will bring the blind by a way *that* they knew not; I will lead them in paths *that* they have not known: I will make darkness light before them, and crooked things straight. These things will I do unto them, and not forsake them.

Psalms 37:28

<sup>28</sup>For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.

Lamentations 3:31-32

<sup>31</sup>For the Lord will not cast off for ever: <sup>32</sup>But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies.

Jeremiah 32:40

<sup>40</sup>And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me.

## Strength and Courage

Isaiah 12:2

<sup>2</sup>Behold, God *is* my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH *is* my strength and *my* song; he also is become my salvation.

Isaiah 40:29-31

<sup>29</sup>He giveth power to the faint; and to *them that have* no might he increaseth strength. <sup>30</sup>Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: <sup>31</sup>But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.



Job 11:15

<sup>15</sup>For then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; yea, thou shalt be stedfast, and shalt not fear.

2 Corinthians 12:9

<sup>9</sup>And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Psalms 31:24

<sup>24</sup>Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.

Zechariah 10:12

<sup>12</sup>And I will strengthen them in the LORD; and they shall walk up and down in his name, saith the LORD.

Psalms 68:35

<sup>35</sup>O God, *thou art* terrible out of thy holy places: the God of Israel *is* he that giveth strength and power unto *his* people. Blessed *be* God.

Isaiah 35:3-4

<sup>3</sup>Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees. <sup>4</sup>Say to them *that are* of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come *with* vengeance, *even* God *with* a recompence; he will come and save you.

Joel 3:16-17

<sup>16</sup>The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD *will be* the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel. <sup>17</sup>So shall ye know that I *am* the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.

2 Timothy 1:7

<sup>7</sup>For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

<sup>26</sup>My flesh and my heart faileth: *but* God *is* the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.

Psalms 147:3

<sup>3</sup>He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.

Isaiah 53:4-5

<sup>4</sup>Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup>But he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

<sup>6</sup>Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth.

<sup>28</sup>Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

<sup>23</sup>Jesus said unto him, if thou canst believe, all things *are* possible to him that believeth.

<sup>50</sup>But when Jesus heard *it*, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.

<sup>24</sup>Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
